To our Colleagues from ETUC, CCOO and UGT,

On behalf of the All-Poland Alliance of Trade Unions (OPZZ) and its member organisations, we would like to express our strong solidarity with the workers, trade unions and citizens taking part in the Euro-Demonstration “For a Democratic Europe: Rally for Quality Jobs, Social Justice and Peace, and against Deregulation and Austerity”, organised in Madrid on 18 June.

Although OPZZ is unable to join you in person, we stand firmly with our European trade union colleagues in your fight for quality jobs, fair wages, secure futures, adequate and affordable housing, peace and social justice.

At a time of rising living costs, growing inequality and increasing pressure to deregulate labour markets, working people must not once again be made to pay the price of crisis and austerity. Europe needs stronger social protection and stronger workers’ rights, not a race to the bottom.

We fully support your call for dignity, safety and respect at work, collective bargaining, public investment and an economy that works for everyone, not just the few. We also share your opposition to deregulation, including any EU Inc. / 28th regime that would undermine labour standards or weaken existing protections.
